6. The Committee reserves the right to amend the Rules at their discretion.
7. **PLEASE NOTE:** Prize money for **field** classes will be available for collection after 12.00 NOON. Please bring your PRIZE CARD(S) to the Secretaries' Tent for collection.
8. Objections, if any, must be made **IN WRITING TO THE SECRETARY** before 3.30 pm on Show Day, with a deposit of £5 which will be forfeited if objection is not upheld. The Committee's decision shall be final.
9. All cups **MUST** be returned to the Show Secretary at least **ONE MONTH PRIOR TO THE SHOW** i.e. **26th July 2023** and **NO LATER**. Late or lost cups will incur a £100 fine or total cost of replacement.
10. The responsibility of the cup is entirely that of the Cup Winner, loss or damage and the value will be charged to the Cup Holder.
11. Cars are parked at the owners' risk.
12. It is the responsibility of all owners / exhibitors to ensure that their animals / exhibits have adequate insurance.
13. No refunds will be given for events cancelled for reasons out of the Committee's control.
14. It is important that any accident should be reported immediately to the Secretary's office so that appropriate action can be taken with regard to Emergency Services and so that it can be recorded in the Accident Book.
15. Lost children/Vulnerable Adults – Arrangements are in place for any children or vulnerable adults, who become separated from their party, to be taken to a place of safety.

Please practice good bio-security measures and exhibitors are reminded that they attend Clynderwen & District YF Show at their own risk, with consideration given to the potential disease risks. Please note this guidance is subject to change.
